It is understood that:

1. If the candidate does not qualify for a reimbursement under *The Election Financing Act*, no reimbursement will be assigned or payable.
2. If the candidate does qualify for reimbursement, it is only that portion of the candidate's reimbursement that is payable to the official agent that is eligible to be assigned. In some instances, part or all of a candidate's reimbursement must be paid to the candidate's endorsing registered party or, in the case of an independent candidate, to the Minister of Finance. Reimbursement payable to the candidate's endorsing registered party or to the Minister of Finance cannot be assigned by a candidate.
3. The loan to the candidate must be in relation to financing election expenses.
4. The maximum amount that will be paid to an assignee is the lesser of:
  - a) the amount payable to the official agent, or
  - b) the outstanding loan balance owing to the lender at the time of making the original payment.
5. If there is more than one lender, the official agent must give direction to the Chief Electoral Officer as to the order of payment.
6. Any advance payments under section 74(4) of *The Election Financing Act* to the official agent are subject to assignment.
7. All requirements of *The Election Financing Act* must be met.
