PROVINCIAL BY-ELECTIONS ARTHUR-VIRDEN AND MORRIS — TUESDAY, JANUARY 28 ELIGIBLE ARTHUR-VIRDEN AND MORRIS VOTERS CAN STILL GET THEIR NAMES ON THE VOTERS LIST

Door-to-door enumeration for the Arthur-Virden and Morris provincial by-elections ends Sunday, but voters who were not home when the enumerator called can still have their names added to the voters list.

Following enumeration, a revision period is held to add, remove or correct names on the voters list. This period begins Monday, January 13 and runs until Thursday, January 16.

Eligible voters can go to the returning office to make any changes or additions. They must bring government issued photo identification (such as a driver's licence) or two other pieces of identification. If they are unable to go in person, they can contact the returning office to arrange to have an election official visit them at home.

The returning office is open every day from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm except Sunday, when it is open from noon until 6:00 pm.
