**PROVINCIAL BY-ELECTION  
THE PAS — TUESDAY, APRIL 21  
ADVANCE VOTING RUNS FOR EIGHT DAYS**

Election day for The Pas by-election is Tuesday, April 21 but eligible voters may vote in advance beginning tomorrow, April 11, until Saturday, April 18.

Unless otherwise noted, advance voting places are open from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm every day except Sunday, when they are open from noon until 6:00 p.m.

Residents of the provincial electoral division of The Pas are eligible to vote if they:

- \* are Canadian citizens
- \* are 18 years of age on or before election day
- \* have resided in Manitoba for at least six months immediately before election day

To vote in advance, voters are required to show one piece of government-issued photo identification (such as a driver's license) or two other documents with their name. Having their enumeration record with them will also be helpful.
