VOTING OPTIONS FOR THE TRANSCONA BYELECTION

Voters in Transcona have many convenient and accessible voting options in the provincial byelection.

MORE ADVANCE VOTING OPPORTUNITIES

Eligible voters can vote at either advance polling location before election day.

Transcona Local Election Office – 100 Paquin Rd.

A polling station will operate at the local election office from Saturday, March 8 daily, up to and including election day, March 18.

All Saints Ukrainian Orthodox Church – 1500 Day St.

This location will be open for advance voting from Saturday, March 8 to Saturday, March 15.

Voting hours are 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. daily, except Sunday noon to 6:00 p.m.

VOTING ON ELECTION DAY

Voters can vote at any polling location on election day, March 18, not just the suggested polling place shown on their voter information card. Polling place information is also available on the Elections Manitoba website.

ABSENTEE VOTING

Transcona voters who will be away from their electoral division on election day and during advance voting can apply for absentee voting. Voters can apply at <https://www.electionsmanitoba.ca/en/Voting/Absentee> or at the local election office. The deadline to apply is March 15 at 8:00 p.m. but voters are encouraged to apply early so that there is enough time to receive and return their ballot.

HOMEBOUND VOTING

Those unable to go in person to a polling place due to a disability may apply to vote at home. Caregivers may also apply to vote at home. Applications are available at <https://www.electionsmanitoba.ca/en/Voting/Accessibility> or from the Transcona local election office. Applications must be received at the local election office by 8:00 p.m. on March 17.

VOTING ASSISTANCE

In addition to homebound voting, Elections Manitoba provides several services to support voters with disabilities:

- Voters may request a language or sign language interpreter. Voters should contact the local election office as early as possible to request this service.

- Polling places have braille ballot templates and magnifiers
- Voters may bring someone with them to help them vote or ask a voting officer for help.
- Voters may use assistive devices, including smart phone apps, to vote.
