PROVINCIAL BYELECTION IN TRANSCONA ADVANCE VOTING BEGINS TOMORROW

Advance voting for the Transcona byelection begins tomorrow, March 8. Eligible voters can vote at either advance polling place.

Voting hours are 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. daily except Sunday, noon to 6:00 p.m.

To be eligible to vote, individuals must:

- Be Canadian citizens
- Be at least 18 years old on election day
- Have lived in Manitoba for at least six months immediately before election day
- Live in the Transcona electoral division

Everyone must show ID to vote, either one piece of government-issued photo ID with your current address (such as a driver's license) or two other pieces.
