## ELECTIONS MANITOBA HOLDS IN-PERSON VOTER REGISTRATION, JUNE 20-24

Elections Manitoba will register voters in person at locations across Winnipeg, as well as in Brandon and Thompson, starting tomorrow. Voters will be able to check if they're registered to vote in the next provincial election, register to vote or update their information.

To register or update information, voters will need to show one piece of government-issued photo ID or two other pieces of ID. Voters who are already registered when they go to vote can be served more quickly at the voting place.
