INTRODUCTION

This Statement of Votes, which includes a summary of votes received, results by polling place and voting area and accompanying maps, covers the byelection for the electoral district of Transcona. The report is published as per section 175 of *The Elections Act* (EA).

The member for Transcona, Nello Altomare, passed away on Jan. 14, 2025. Pursuant to Order in Council number 37/2025, the chief electoral officer issued the writ of election to the returning officer for Transcona on Feb. 18, 2025. The returning officer for Transcona was Klara Giesbrecht and the assistant returning officer was Krystle Cramer.

Advance voting was held from Saturday, March 8 to Monday, March 17. This included two additional days of advance voting at the local election office. Election day was Tuesday, March 18, 2025.

MODIFICATION TO THE VOTING PROCESS

One modification to the voting process was used in the Transcona byelection, as approved by the Standing Committee on Legislative Affairs, pursuant to section 28.1 of *The Elections Act*.

This modification builds on recent changes to voting to increase voting opportunities and convenience for Manitobans. The modification extended advance voting for an additional two days at the local election office (the Sunday and Monday immediately preceding election day), plus added election day voting at the local election office. In the case of a general election, voters would be able to vote at any local election office in Manitoba.

A full report on the modification will be included in the Elections Manitoba annual report for 2024.

VOTING OPPORTUNITIES

In addition to regular voting on election day, Transcona voters were able to vote at advance polls, extended advance voting at the local election office, voting from home and absentee voting and at institutional voting stations.

Election Day Voting

Election day was Tuesday, March 18, 2025. Voting on election day was held from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Regular voting took place at 30 polls within 11 different polling places.

On election day, 3,011 votes (56.3% of all votes) were cast at regular polling places.

Advance Voting

Advance voting was held at All Saints Ukrainian Orthodox Church from Saturday, March 8 to Saturday, March 15.

Advance voting was also held at the local election office, located at 100 Paquin Road, from Saturday, March 8 to Tuesday, March 17, as per the previously noted modification to the voting process. This allowed voters the opportunity to cast their ballot from the start of the advance voting until election day.

During advance voting, 2,418 votes were cast (42.9% of all votes).

Institutional Voting

Institutional voting stations are set up on election day at locations such as health care facilities, seniors' residences, and long-term care facilities. In larger facilities, polls run all of election day. In smaller facilities, polls run for several hours before moving to another facility. These are referred to as institutional mobile voting stations.

There were 159 votes cast (2.8% of all votes) at institutions.

Other Voting Opportunities

Voting From Home (Home): This is available in all elections for voters who are unable to go to a polling place because of a disability, as well as the caregivers of these voters.

Absentee Voting: Any eligible voter who was away from their electoral division during advance voting and on election day can vote as an absentee voter.

Personal Security Voting (PSV): People with concerns about their personal security may apply to have their name and personal information obscured or omitted from the voters list.

Outside of ED Institutional Voting: Under *The Elections Act*, a voter incarcerated in a correctional facility is deemed a resident of the electoral division where they resided immediately before their incarceration. People in hospitals also get the opportunity to vote from outside their electoral division. These votes are reported as "outside of ED — institutional" votes.

Election Day Voting at the LEO: With the modification to the voting process used in this byelection, voters could cast their ballot at the local election office on election day.

Due to the small number of votes cast using these methods, to protect the secrecy of the vote the results are reported together on the Statement of Official Results.

There were 42 votes cast with these options.

VOTES BY VOTING METHOD

The following chart compares the number of ballots cast by voting method in the byelection with the number cast in the ED during the 2023 general election. Voter turnout in the byelection was 31.3%, based on 17,962 registered voters. In the 2023 general election, voter turnout was 51.4%, based on 17,498 registered voters.






