Elections Manitoba is hiring facilitators to deliver in-class workshops for our education program, *Your Power to Choose*. Fun and interactive, the workshops touch on the history of elections in Manitoba, the process of making informed decisions and end with a simulated election.

Elections Manitoba offers workshops to classes from grade 4 to 12 and adult learners throughout the province. Workshops are one to one-and-a-half hours long. All support materials and facilitator 'scripts' are supplied by Elections Manitoba. **Paid training is provided.**

Qualifications:

- Previous experience in a classroom setting
- Previous experience in a leadership role with children and youth an asset
- A desire to participate in the electoral process through this public education and information program
- No political affiliations
- Bilingual (English/French) is an asset
- A valid driver's license and access to transportation

Facilitators are expected to be available on an on-going, as-needed basis to conduct workshops between the months of September and June, with some flexibility in scheduling. **Facilitators receive \$65 per workshop with mileage reimbursed for travel.**

Elections Manitoba is an independent (*non-partisan*) office of the Legislative Assembly. Its job is to ensure the democratic rights of all Manitobans through the conduct of free and fair elections.
